

AACN Tour Program and Registration Form

Stone Mountain Park: Sunday, May 20; 9:00 AM – 3:30 PM

Experience a day of fun at Atlanta's most visited attraction, Georgia Stone Mountain Park, often referred to as the "Eighth Wonder of the World." This park features the world's largest relief carving on the world's largest mass of exposed granite. View the mountain's majestic carvings of General Robert E. Lee, "Stonewall" Jackson and Jefferson Davis from the newly renovated Memorial Hall. Choose from a variety of activities available, such as a visit back in time to the days of Scarlett and Rhett as you tour the authentic Antebellum Plantation and its 18 outbuildings, enjoy a spectacular view by taking the skylift to the top of the mountain; relax on a paddle wheel river boat cruise; or slowly ride around the mountain on a train. Cost includes a pass at all major park attractions. Lunch will be on your own during this tour.

Homes of the Old South, Lunch at the Blue Willow Inn: Sunday, May 20; 9:30 AM – 4:00 PM

Come along with us and experience a touch of the past as we visit historic Covington. Covington is about a forty-five minute drive from the convention center. Our first stop, Sandtown Place was built in 1840 and your visit to this restored southern home is a trip into early American history. The original structural art show hand-hewn timbers and wide board ceiling and floors. In addition, there is an 1880 general store representing a supermarket of yesteryear. Tour the main and second floor, outbuildings and gardens. Next we head for the internationally acclaimed Blue Willow Inn Restaurant, which is housed in a turn-of-the-century Greek Revival mansion. Here at Blue Willow you will experience a wonderful buffet-style lunch which includes an array of southern dishes. After lunch our next stop is Boxwood in historic Covington. Boxwood was constructed in 1830 and the first meeting of the trustees of Emory College was held in the house. The home is furnished with early American, Victorian and Empire furniture. There is also a large collection of Napoleon memorabilia and other fine porcelains. Both homeowners will be available for questions.

The Atlantic History Museum and Buckhead Shopping: Sunday, May 20; 10:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Explore the exclusive residential area of North Atlanta known as Buckhead. You'll enjoy the scenic drive through beautiful mansions on your way to the Governor's Mansion and the Atlanta History Center. Featured at the Atlanta History Center is the Italian Renaissance style Swan House, a classical-style mansion that has been transformed into a museum of decorative. A highlight is a viewing of the largest collection of Civil War artifacts in the Southeast. After exploring Atlanta's past, it's time to shop 'til you drop! Today's tour will end at the premier shopping district, conveniently located just down Peachtree Street in the heart of Buckhead. Fabulous shopping at two of the largest shopping centers in Atlanta, the Phipps Plaza and Lenox Square, awaits you! There's something for everyone from Saks Fifth Ave., Bloomingdale's, Gucci and Tiffany & Co. at the Phipps Plaza to Neiman Marcus and Macy's at Lenox Square. You're sure to find a place to have lunch on your own at one of the many fine eateries.
